OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: Discussion on letter received written from the Clerk on behalf of the Mayor and Council. This issue came up at a Council Meeting and the Council felt that it should be handled by the Planning Board to review the Land Use Ordinance to see if any revisions or updates need to be made. Barrie suggested creating a committee to work on this due to it being such a large project. Jim Janone said the focus should be on items that have currently come up. Hector Lorenzo wanted to know what the time line and budget concern for this is. A committee should be able to detail all of what Jim is suggesting. Diane Feola asked how this came up within the Council. Mayor Holeman said one of the council people brought it up.

Details of what a committee will be doing and how they will be coming up with changes was discussed along with why we need a committee.

Much more discussion on who brought this up, do we really need to look at and change items, the process involved in getting something changed, what the law requires, the council's role in this, the time involved in getting something changed, who needs to review it and changes that the reviews may want, the master plan review and should we continue to discuss this. The attorney said you have a lot going on here and you need an appropriate budget before you undertake this. Jim Janone suggested tabling this for the next year and start at the beginning of the year and looking for funding. The attorney suggested the same and that the council liaison could make a presentation for the council in writing or in person and make your pitch for the next budget or the year after.

There was some discussion from the professionals on what their part would be in this process. Different areas of concerns were discussed; accessory structures, commercial vehicles and recreation vehicles.

There was a discussion about if the Administrative Committee and another committee were still active? They are there was never a vote to inactivate them. The following members are on the committee; Hector Lorenzo, Jim Janone, Ken Diehl and Valerie Williams. Jim Janone expressed he could not be a member of the committee due to his work schedule.

It was suggested that Dave Zimmerman be given the three areas, accessory structures, commercial vehicles and recreation vehicles to look at. We ask him to come up with samples of changing those areas, regulating them, how many hours it may take for him and we get that response and then present them to Council with a budget that we need and then we can move forward with them.

Hector Lorenzo made the motion to add land use review to existing sub committee
Ken Diehl seconded it.
